Scope of Services:

The Consultant agrees to provide professional consulting services to the Client as described in Schedule A attached hereto. The Consultant shall perform the services with reasonable skill, care, and diligence in accordance with generally accepted professional standards.

Fees and Payment:

The Client shall pay the Consultant the fees set forth in Schedule B attached hereto. Invoices shall be issued monthly in arrears and payable within 30 days of receipt. All payments shall be made in GBP unless otherwise agreed in writing. Late payments shall bear interest at the statutory rate under UK law.

Confidentiality:

Each party agrees to keep confidential and not disclose to any third party any Confidential Information received from the other party, except as required by law or agreed in writing. This clause shall survive termination of this Agreement.

Intellectual Property:

All intellectual property rights arising from the Consultant's services under this Agreement shall be the sole and exclusive property of the Client, subject to any pre-existing rights disclosed in writing by the Consultant. The Consultant grants the Client a perpetual, worldwide, royalty-free licence to use all deliverables.

Liability and Indemnity:

The Consultant shall maintain appropriate professional indemnity insurance throughout the term of this Agreement. Except for liability arising from gross negligence, wilful misconduct, or fraud, the Consultant's total liability shall not exceed the fees paid under this Agreement. Each party shall indemnify and hold harmless the other from any claims arising from breach of this Agreement or negligence.

Termination:

Either party may terminate this Agreement by giving 30 days' written notice to the other party. The Client may terminate immediately for cause if the Consultant breaches any material obligations. On termination, the Consultant shall deliver all work in progress and the Client shall pay for all services performed up to termination date.

Data Protection:

Both parties shall comply with applicable data protection laws including the UK GDPR. Personal data shall only be processed for the purposes of this Agreement and handled securely.

Governing Law and Jurisdiction:

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales. The parties submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales for any disputes arising out of or in connection with this Agreement.

Entire Agreement:

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements and understandings relating to its subject matter. Any amendments must be made in writing and signed by both parties.

Severability:

If any provision of this Agreement is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

Waiver:

No failure or delay by either party in exercising any right shall operate as a waiver of that or any other right.

Force Majeure:

Neither party shall be liable for any failure or delay in performance due to causes beyond their reasonable control including acts of God, war, terrorism, strikes, or governmental restrictions.
