RECITALS:

WHEREAS, the Parties contemplate legal marriage under the laws of the United Kingdom and desire to establish their respective rights and responsibilities regarding each other's property and financial matters prior to marriage; AND WHEREAS, the Parties intend this Agreement to be a legally binding contract and to be enforceable under UK law; NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein, the Parties agree as follows:

1. DEFINITIONS

For purposes of this Agreement, the following terms shall have the meanings set forth herein. 'Separate Property' means property owned by a Party before the marriage, or acquired by gift or inheritance during the marriage. 'Marital Property' means all property acquired during the marriage that is not Separate Property.

2. DISCLOSURE

Each Party acknowledges that they have fully and fairly disclosed to the other Party all of their assets, liabilities, and financial obligations as of the date of this Agreement.

3. SEPARATE PROPERTY

All Separate Property of each Party shall remain their sole and exclusive property, free from any claim or interest of the other Party.

4. MARITAL PROPERTY

Any property acquired jointly or individually during the marriage, except as Separate Property, shall be considered Marital Property and subject to division upon divorce, annulment, or legal separation.

5. DEBTS AND LIABILITIES

Each Party shall be solely responsible for their Separate Debts incurred before or after the marriage. Joint debts shall be the joint responsibility of both Parties.

6. SPOUSAL SUPPORT

The Parties waive any right to spousal maintenance or support, except as otherwise agreed in writing or required by law.

7. WAIVER OF RIGHTS

Each Party waives any rights to the other's Separate Property and any statutory rights to elective shares, dower, or curtesy.

8. GOVERNING LAW

This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of England and Wales.

9. AMENDMENTS

This Agreement may only be amended or revoked by a written instrument signed by both Parties.

10. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable, the remainder shall remain valid and enforceable.

11. INDEPENDENT LEGAL ADVICE

Each Party acknowledges that they have had the opportunity to seek independent legal advice prior to executing this Agreement.

12. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Agreement shall become effective immediately upon the Parties' marriage.

13. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

This Agreement contains the entire understanding between the Parties and supersedes all prior agreements or understandings.

14. EXECUTION

This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and all together shall constitute one and the same instrument.
